Focus on positrons, hollow channels, emittance.**



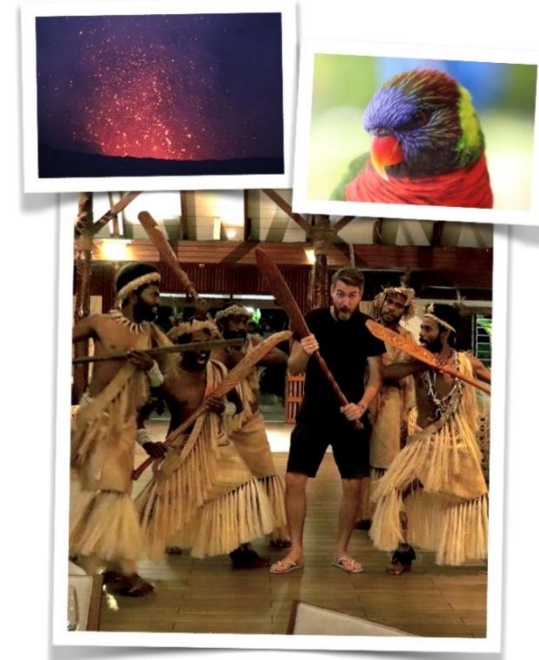
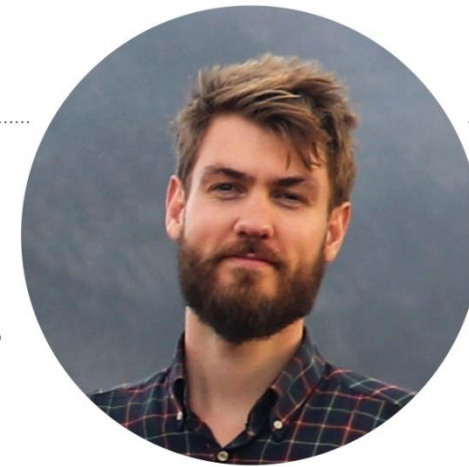
2016–2018 (part of PhD)
